Benton Harbor star top Michigan player

DETROIT — Wilson Chandler was considered one of Michigan's best prep basketball players at the beginning of the season.

By the end, he was the best.

The 18-year-old Benton Harbor forward yesterday was named the 25th recipient of the Hal Schram Mr. Basketball award, which is given annually to the state's outstanding senior player based on voting by the Basketball Coaches Association of Michigan.

Chandler received 890 points to place well ahead of runner-up Michael Bramos of Grosse Pointe North. Bramos finished with 341 points, and Olivet's Zane Gay was third with 325.

"It's a great honor," Chandler said. "You look at some of the guys who have won this before, and I hope I'll be like some of them one day, winning national championships and playing in the NBA."

The 6-7 DePaul recruit averaged 22 points, 12 rebounds and three assists per game.

Chandler, while thrilled to win the award, is disappointed he won't be playing for a state title.

The Tigers entered last week's Class A regional playoffs as the

state's No. 1 team and ranked 11th nationally by USA Today, but were upset Friday by No. 6 Holt, 58-54 in overtime. Chandler scored 20 points in the loss, which ended the Tigers' season at 24-1.

"If I could, I would trade this for a state championship," he said.

Benton Harbor coach Ramsey Nichols, himself a Mr. Basketball finalist in 1989, said Chandler's development as a ballhandler and shooter made him the best player in the state.

"He made that one big leap," he said. "At first he was just an inside player, but he gradually became a better ballhandler and shooter and passer. That's what makes him so complete."

The award, he added, also means something to the city, which has seen its share of tough times in recent years.

"We haven't had the greatest of times, so to have such a positive light shine on a young person from our community means a lot. It's a great example for other young people."

Chandler considered Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue, Indiana, Connecticut, Florida and Xavier before committing to DePaul.
