

N. Toledo man catches burglar Householder, 61, tackles suspect, holds him for police

A 61-year-old North Toledo man avoided being robbed for a second time in the same week Thursday when he chased a burglar from his home, tackled him in the front yard, and held

him until police arrived, authorities said. Anthony M. Soto, 39, of 2139 Lisa Lane was arraigned yesterday in Toledo Municipal Court for burglary and unrelated charges of domestic violence and assault.

He is being held in the Lucas County jail in lieu of \$22,500 bond. A preliminary hearing in

the case has been scheduled for Thursday.

John Miller went to his home in the 2100 block of Mulberry Street about 3:25 p.m. Thursday, put his key in the door, and went to push it open when he felt someone pushing back, Toledo police Detective Kermit Quinn said.

When Mr. Miller opened the door, he saw a man running out the back. He chased the man outside, tackled him in the front yard, and held him down.

A police crew patrolling the area passed by and Mr. Miller

flagged the officers down to arrest the man, Detective Quinn

Mr. Miller's home was burglarized Tuesday and a number of guns were taken.

In Thursday's burglary, the suspect apparently entered through the back door that was broken in the previous burglary and tried to take ammunition from the Miller home, the detective said.

St. Joan of Arc Elementary School, 5950 Heatherdowns Blvd., on Oct. 22, leaving a message on an answering machine with a threat to blow up the school two days later.
