

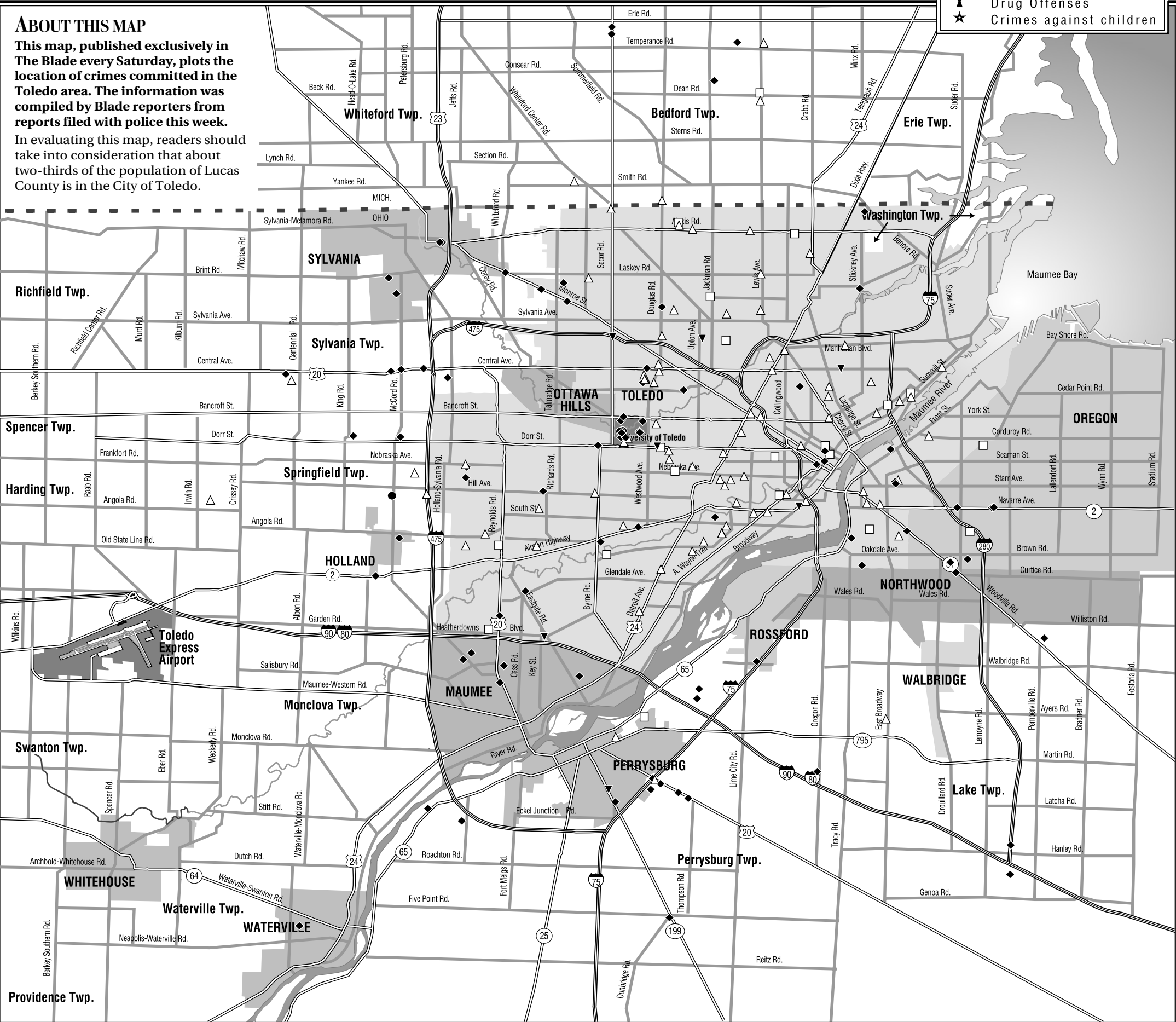

Officials seek tips on cornfield fires

PALMYRA, Mich. — Michigan State Police and the Palmyra Fire Department are seeking information about several cornfield fires in Lenawee County during the last two weeks. Two acres of corn were set on fire Oct. 22 about 4 p.m. on East Mulberry Road near Arnold Highway. A field of corn stubble was set ablaze Wednesday about 3:45 p.m. at 7503 Rouget Rd., and another fire was set about

20 minutes later on Fike Road near Neuroth Highway, authorities said. A green pickup and a white car were seen in the area of the first fire. Authorities said several similar cornfield fires have occurred in two neighboring counties. Anyone with information is asked to call Lenawee County Crime Stoppers at 517-266-6161 or 1-877-276-8477. Man held on drug, gun charges

A North Toledo man arrested yesterday on several drug-related charges was being held in the Lucas County jail pending his arraignment Monday in Toledo Municipal Court. Aaron Holt, 32, of 330 Oakland St. was charged with drug abuse, drug trafficking, and having weapons under disability.

Lucas County sheriff's deputies served a search warrant at Holt's house about 8:30 a.m. and said they had found more than three ounces of heroin worth about \$12,000 and a loaded shotgun and handgun. Authorities said they have been investigating Holt for three months.

Toledoan indicted for rape in UT library

An Old West End man has been indicted by a Lucas County grand jury for sexually abusing a 20-year-old, mentally disabled woman on the second floor of the University of Toledo's Carlson Library at 6:15 p.m. Oct. 10.

Valentin Havugiyaremye, 38, of 1951 Scott St. is charged with rape and gross sexual imposition, both felonies. He was being held in the county jail pending arraignment Thursday in Lucas County Common Pleas Court.
