
A Place for Everything



Round-top windows, shutters and brick trim provide a welcoming façade to this well designed one-story home.



A charming front porch, gorgeous arched windows, and a well balanced layout inside all combine in this design.

A central foyer routes traffic efficiently to all areas in a floor plan zoned for convenient living. To the right of the foyer are two sizable bedrooms and a study or third bedroom. The master suite offers a roomy feeling with its sloping ceiling and sliding glass doors to its patio retreat. The large and luxurious master bath features a generous walk-in closet, vanity, twin sinks, linen closet, stall shower, and garden tub.

To the rear are the living areas, which include the

family gathering room and the dining area. The open planning of these rooms contributes to the feeling of spaciousness. The gathering room has a sloping ceiling and a centered fireplace.

The dining room has a nine-foot ceiling and sliding glass doors to the dining patio, a great place of adjournment for coffee and dessert. Note the corner china cabinet for easy storage.

A step away is the kitchen with nook and snack bar for informal eating. Around the bend, a walk-in pantry and large laundry room add to the home's functionality.
