Narrative: Richard Vanlandingham III attempted to enter the City Council Chambers with a large sign, and was told by Sgt at Arms Mosely that no signs were permitted. Mr. Vanlandingham stated he had First Amendment rights, and again attempted to go in. Officer Mosely blocked his way, stating he was allowed to go in, but was not allowed to take the sign in. Mr. Vanlandingham attempted to push his way past Officer Mosely, and was placed under arrest. As Officer Mosely was arresting him, a Meghan Link began to push Mosely, and was arrested by the State Trooper after a short scuffle. Meghan Link had to be partly carried out of the building, refusing to walk. Mr. Vanlandingham was checked at the scene by the fire department for an asthma attack, then booked at the jail.
