

2011 HOMICIDES

Thirty-eight people were killed in Toledo last year, two of whom were shot by police in cases that were ruled justified homicides.



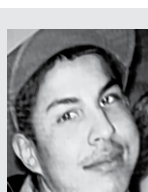
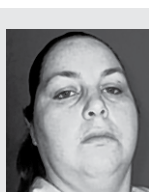
Allam Ibrahim, 48
Found dead Jan. 11 of an assault.
■ Status: Unsolved



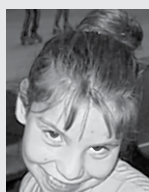
James Schueler, 65
Shot in the head on Jan. 27.
■ Status: Mark A. Langlois, 50, supervised by Mr. Schueler at Forklifts, was sentenced in November to life in prison for the shooting death.



Holly Zimmer, 32
Died after being run over by a car on Feb. 13.
■ Status: Brent Peace, 39, Ms. Zimmer's boyfriend, pleaded no contest to aggravated vehicular homicide, tampering with evidence, and failure to stop after an accident. He was sentenced in October to 10 years in prison.



Tamara McDaniel, 39; Damien Reyes, 18; Domonique Reyes, 16; Taralynn Wood, 10
Died of carbon monoxide poisoning on March 22.
■ Status: Landlord Steven Snow found guilty of four counts of reckless homicide and placed on community control, including six months in custody, for placing a gas-powered generator inside the home where the family was living.



Charles Harris, Jr., 71
Shot in the head on April 13.
■ Status: Kenneth Anderson, 29, was sentenced in October to life in prison with the possibility of parole after 20 years for aggravated murder and a gun specification. He said he intended to rob Mr. Harris, who was putting away lawn equipment. The trial of Thomas Johnson, 21, charged with tampering with evidence, is expected to start Jan. 9.



Samuel Birch, 24
Shot by police on April 16 when police tried to serve an arrest warrant; Birch shot an officer in the leg during the incident.
■ Status: Ruled justifiable by the Toledo Police Department.



David Wallerstein, 36
Found suffering from gunshot wounds at Broadway and Western Avenue on April 17. He died at Mercy St. Vincent Medical Center.
■ Status: unsolved



Jennifer Molnar, 31
Found beaten to death in the basement of her East Toledo home on June 8.
■ Status: unsolved



Montelle Taylor, 17
Shot while riding his bicycle on Auburn Avenue near Bancroft Street on June 10.
■ Status: unsolved



Randall York, 55
Struck by a car and trapped beneath after an argument at a gas station in West Toledo on June 11.
■ Status: Geoffrey A. Dupuis, 47, received a life sentence in December for the dragging death.



Marquan McQuin, 18
Shot while riding his bicycle in a South Toledo alley in the 1100 block of Gordon Street on July 3.
■ Status: Gerald Banks, 18, was sentenced to life in prison in December for the shooting death.



Eric Daniels, 40
Shot at an impromptu car show in central Toledo on July 5.
■ Status: Byron Mitchell, 20, is charged with Mr. Daniels' murder. He is scheduled for a pretrial hearing in Lucas County Common Pleas Court on Jan. 23.



Jeffrey Poindexter, 26
Found dead of multiple gunshot wounds on his porch in the 1400 block of Delaware Avenue on Aug. 5.
■ Status: unsolved



Christopher Moles, 40
Struck by an alleged drunken driver while crossing the street in the 700 block of West Laskey on Aug. 20.
■ Status: Kadie McCurdy, 27, is charged with aggravated vehicular homicide. She has a trial date of Jan. 23.



Christopher Lawrence, 39
Shot in the head while sitting in a truck in the 1300 block of Foster Avenue. Lawrence died at Toledo Hospital on Aug. 22.
■ Status: unsolved



Quidare Buffaloe, 23
Shot while talking to a group of people in a parking lot in the 1600 block of Fielding Avenue Aug. 28.
■ Status: unsolved



Brian Lipp, 48
Shot by police on Sept. 3 after Lipp, wanted for a number of armed robberies, was shot by officers from multiple agencies after leading police on a two-county wrong-way chase and crash on I-75 that resulted in the death of an innocent motorist.
■ Status: In September, a Lucas County grand jury recommended that no charges be brought and that officers responded correctly in the shooting.



Michael Cobb, 54
Shot in the chest with a knife; he died at the University of Toledo Medical Center on Sept. 19.
■ Status: Jackie Kenney-Cobb, 41, the victim's estranged wife, has been charged in the death. Facing charges of aggravated murder, aggravated burglary, and murder, she is scheduled to appear in Lucas County Common Pleas Court on Wednesday for a pretrial hearing.



Andrew Baker and Tanja Cathey, both 28
Shot to death inside their home in the 2200 block of Sanford Street in central Toledo on Sept. 29. Their 2-year-old son, who was at home with the couple, was spared.
■ Status: unsolved



Justin Smith, 25
Shot on Fernwood Avenue on Oct. 23 while at a memorial for his friend, Deandre Green, 21, who was killed in West Toledo on the same date in 2010.
■ Status: Martreese Dobson, 24, was charged with the murder. His case was bound over to the Lucas County grand jury on Dec. 27.



Howard Williams, 40
Shot during a domestic dispute in the 1800 block of Ottawa Drive on Oct. 24.
■ Status: Police named April Jones, 50, the victim's wife, as the suspect. She was hospitalized after the incident and has not been charged with the crime.



Alvaro Vallejo, Jr., 35
Shot while a passenger inside a car, traveling near Broadway and Prouty Avenue, on Oct. 26.
■ Status: Livorio Sandoval, 27, is charged with the murder. He is scheduled for a pretrial hearing on Jan. 24.



Michael Heidtman, 29
Shot while at a home in West Toledo in the 4100 block of Lewis Avenue on Oct. 26.
■ Status: Paul Cooper, 32, pleaded not guilty to the shooting death. He has a trial date set for Jan. 10.



Darnell Townsend-Tall, 36
Shot at his 339 E. Weber St. home during a home invasion on Nov. 7.
■ Status: Three men are charged in the shooting death — Reynard Lewis, 20; Darrick Newsome, 18, and Kurt Finley, 19. Mr. Newsome and Mr. Finley have a Feb. 13 trial date.



Raynail Gaiter, 31
Shot inside his Ravine Village Park apartment during a home invasion on Nov. 10.
■ Status: Six men, including the three charged in Townsend-Tall's death, are charged. In addition to Mr. Lewis, Mr. Newsome, and Mr. Finley, Kevin Arnold, 22, Quandre Willingham, 22, and Samojay Edwards, 19, are charged. Mr. Edwards has a trial of Feb. 7; Mr. Finley has a trial of Jan. 31; Arnold has a trial date of Jan. 17; Mr. Willingham has a date of Jan. 24.



Lamar Allen, 25
Shot by a store clerk as the victim was, with another man, robbing Express Carryout, 1920 Mulberry St., on Nov. 21.
■ Status: The Toledo Police Department will present the case to a grand jury in January.



Timothy Blair, 14, and Veronica Serrano, 34
Shot at the family's Page Street home after Timothy was involved in an argument with a suspect. Timothy died at the scene; Ms. Serrano, Timothy's mother, died at a hospital after the Nov. 26 incident.
■ Status: Daurin Patton, 26, is charged with two counts of aggravated murder and one count of aggravated robbery. He pleaded not guilty in December; a trial date has not been set.



Scott Holzhauser, 47
Beaten inside his home at 842 Lorain St. on Nov. 26. He is shown with a birthmark on his face.
■ Status: Brandon Hoffman, 28, a friend of the victim, is charged with aggravated murder and aggravated robbery. He pleaded not guilty and was scheduled for a Jan. 18 pretrial.



Tyrone Patterson, 23
Shot on Nov. 30 at East Delaware Avenue and Walnut Street.
■ Status: An arrest warrant has been issued for Quintin Helm, 20.



Dana Frison, 38
Shot during a home invasion on Dec. 17 in the 500 block of Platt Street.
■ Status: unsolved



Ronald Mannor, 23
Shot in the back during an argument outside a home in the 800 block of Dunwood Court on Dec. 17.
■ Status: Julian Pina, 20, was charged with the death. The suspect was indicted by a Lucas County grand jury on Dec. 28.



Antonio Johnson, 27
Shot Dec. 30 in the 1900 block of Parkdale.
■ Status: The victim's cousin, James C. Smith, has been arrested and charged in the death.



Deadrick Rocker, 17
Shot and killed Dec. 31 at Hoag and Tecumseh Streets; a 16-year-old was critically wounded.
■ Status: unsolved
