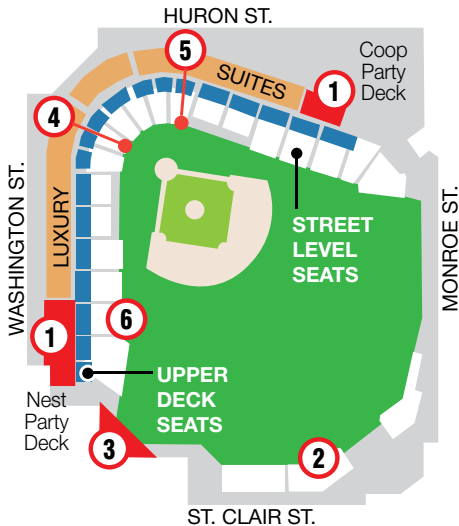


The best seats

Here's a look at a half dozen of the best seats at Fifth Third Field:

- 1. Party Decks.** These group seating areas in left and right field are a great place to stretch out.
- 2. Section 121.** Picnic tables in the Home Run Picnic Terraces make this a prime spot to catch a ball or a bite to eat.
- 3. Section 221, Row A.** ESPN.com rated these seats in the right field area— dubbed The Roost – as the best in the minor leagues.
- 4. Section 112 Row B, Seat 8.** This puts you roughly 60 feet behind home plate and teaches you that curveballs are not optical illusions.
- 5. Section 108, Row B, Seat 8.** Want to chat with a player on deck? This is the spot to do it, although he probably won't answer.
- 6. Section 118, Row A, Seat 15.** Pay attention because you're close to the field and a foul ball might come whistling your way.

Mud Hens tickets cost \$9 (opening day is \$10). You can visit the Swamp Shop, 406 Washington St., outside the ball park and get them there, buy them at the gate if the game's not sold out, or you can order them online at www.mudhens.com or by calling 419-725-HENS.

Within a quarter-mile of Fifth Third Field in downtown Toledo there are over 6,500 parking spaces. Just bring a \$10 bill and you'll find a place and have a few dollars left over.

• Parking in city spots after 5 p.m. is free, so that's an option.
