











Number of Adoptions

- Pit Bull Changes
 - Significant law changes
 - 213 Pit Bull type dogs/puppies transferred in 2012, up from 199 in 2011
 - 98 Pit Bull type dogs/puppies adopted directly from the LCDW in 2012
 - Fix-A-Bull almost complete less than 50 surgeries still available
