The facts tending to establish the foregoing grounds for the issuance of a Search Warrant are as follows:

- 1. Officer Jason Kottenbrock has been with the Ottawa Police Department for eleven (11) years, and has been in law enforcement for twelve (12) years.
- 2. On May 9, 2013, at approximately 5:32am, a call was made to the Putnam County Sheriff's Office by Michelle Grothouse, where she reported three (3) missing juveniles, that her 2006 silver Chevrolet HHR was missing, and that there was blood found inside her residence along with a handgun.
- Officer Jason Kottenbrock arrived on scene within minutes after he was dispatched to Elcrest Trailer Court, 1570 North Perry Street, Lot 61, in the Village of Ottawa, Putnam County, Ohio.
- 4. Michelle Grothouse resides at the Elcrest Trailer Court, 1570 North Perry Street, Lot 61, in the Village of Ottawa, Putnam County, Ohio, a white with brown trim mobile home trailer, with an enclosed porch with two (2) entry doors, and a doorway on the west side, with a detached storage shed, tan in color with a white roof.
- 5. Officer Kottenbrock spoke with Michelle Grothouse upon his arrival. Ms. Grothouse advised she is the mother of two (2) boys, Blane Romes, fourteen (14) years old, and Blake Romes, seventeen (17) years old, who resides with her at said address, along with Vicky Fay, and her son, Michael Aaron Fay, being under the age of eighteen (18). All five (5) individuals reside together at the above noted address.
- 6. Ms. Grothouse advised Officer Kottenbrock that she called home at 5am to speak with her son who was leaving for a class trip, but she was unable to make contact. She further advised she went home where she noticed her silver 2006 Chevrolet HHR vehicle was missing, she entered said residence and saw blood on the floor and a gun laying on the couch, and all three juveniles were missing.
- 7. Officer Kottenbrock was permitted into the home by Michelle Grothouse and he observed blood once he entered the entry door in the hallway, blood on the floor, a .22 caliber hand gun was seen laying on the couch, and a magazine to the gun was found on the floor.
- 8. Upon further investigation, Officer Kottenbrock observed blood throughout the house, the hallway, and into one of the bedrooms. Once inside the bedroom Officer Kottenbrock observed two (2) single beds within said bedroom with one (1) bed having blood on it towards the upper part of the bed.
- 9. Vicky Fay, who was also present upon Officer Kottenbrock's arrival, advised that the handgun found on the couch was her gun, and only she and her sons, Kyle Nichols (who resides at 13101 State Route 15, Ottawa, Putnam County, Ohio), and Michael Aaron Fay, had access to said gun.

- 10. Officer Kottenbrock observed the trail of blood to lead from the bedroom to the back entry door to the west side of the mobile home trailer.
- 11. Officer Kottenbrock further observed tire marks near the back door to the west side of the mobile trailer where it appeared as if something was drug through the grass. The tire tracks lead away from the mobile home trailer.
- 12. To date, the whereabouts and the condition of the three (3) named juveniles are unknown but it appears one (1) or more of the juveniles may be injured, and/or the victim(s) of a crime.
- 13. The schools where the three (3) juveniles attend have been contacted and have failed to appear to school.
- 14. The local medical care facilities have been contacted and have not reported that any of the three (3) named juveniles have presented to their facilities for treatment.
- 15. An attempt to locate has been issued for the three (3) missing juveniles and the 2006 silver Chevrolet HHR.
- 16. The property located at 1570 North Perry Street, Lot 61, in the Village of Ottawa, Putnam County, Ohio, has been secured by law enforcement for further processing.
- 17. The undersigned believes that a search of said residence will uncover evidence of the following crimes: Murder, in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2903.02, a felony of the 1st degree, and or Kidnapping, in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2905.01, a felony of the 1st degree and any other related offenses.
