




We found Sony's XAV-AX100 model to be well reviewed. It works with Apple or Android and includes a physical knob for adjusting the volume. **Best Buy for \$349.99.** 



**Dash Cam:** A dash cam essentially serves two purposes. It lets you document and preserve your road trips and can provide video proof of any incidents you might encounter on the road. There are lots of choices out there, but the Falcon Zero F360 is an intriguing option that has a pair of cameras that can be aimed in a number of ways, including recording inside the cabin — something rideshare drivers might like.
