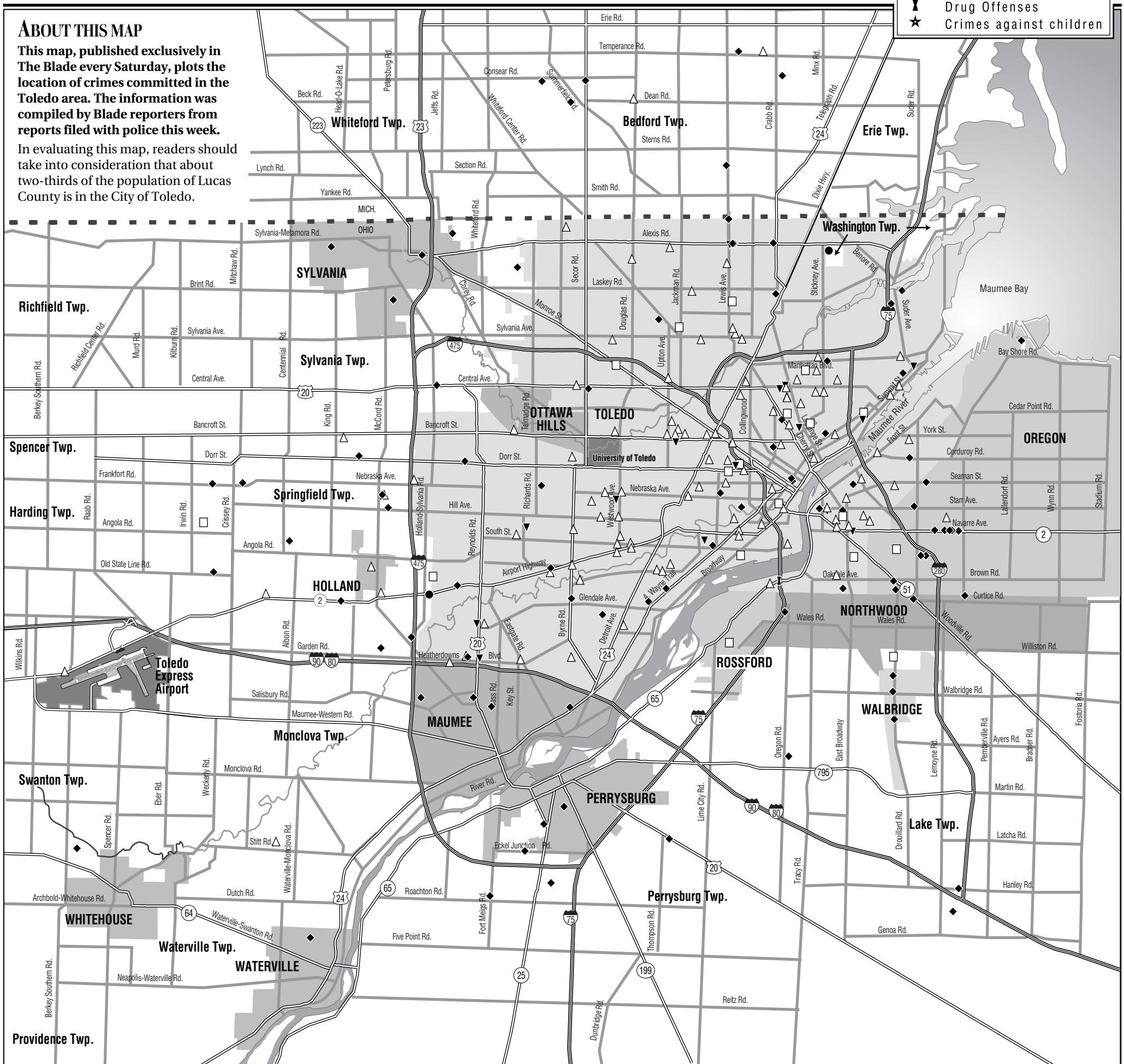
POLICE REPORTS IN AND AROUND TOLEDO

Suspects arrested after holdup at Galena Street discount store

Toledo police arrested two men after a holdup Thursday at a North Toledo store.

Tyrice A. Hill, 22, of 540 Acklin Ave. and Henry L. Redmond, 24, of 2121 Ontario St. were charged with aggravated robbery after police said they robbed the Dollar and More, 525 Galena St. They were being

held in the Lucas County jail in lieu of \$50,000 bonds after arraignments yesterday in Toledo Municipal Court.

Police were sent to the store about 2 p.m. on a robbery alarm.

One of the suspects fled down an alley on a bicycle. Police said officers caught him

after a chase.

After further investigation, detectives arrested Mr. Redmond, who they said acted as a lookout in the robbery.

Detectives said they believe the men were involved in other recent robberies, and they intend to present evidence to a Lucas County grand jury soon.

Authorities snare 37 in citywide sweep

Toledo police arrested 37 people this week during a citywide sweep that focused on those wanted for domestic violence

and assault-related offenses.

The two-day sweep resulted in the clearance of 85 warrants, including 33 for domestic

violence, 45 for misdemeanor offenses, and seven for felony crimes. The sweep was Wednesday and Thursday.

Bicyclist injured after hitting truck in North Toledo

A Toledo man was in critical condition with a skull fracture last night after his bicycle collided with a pickup at Bennett Road and Pasadena Boulevard in North Toledo, authorities said.

Floyd Smith, 63, of 4521 Burnham Ave. was being treated in St. Vincent Mercy Medical Center.

Police said he rode into the path of the pickup, which was traveling south on Bennett, about 6:20 p.m. Thursday. The pickup driver, Richard Black, Jr., 23, of 3029 Chase St. tried to avoid Mr. Smith but couldn't and collided with the bicycle.

Mr. Smith, who was not wearing a helmet, was thrown from the bicycle. Police do not know why he turned into the pickup's path. Mr. Black was not hurt. He was wearing a seat belt, police said.
